ered. We distribute family meals to food insecure families.



Consider serving in several ways:






Saint Vincent de Paul Conference



The Saint Vincent de Paul organization at Our Lady of the Lake is one of many Conferences in Oregon. Our Conference periodically assists other Conferences when their needs exceed their capacity to help and do God's work.

Our SVdP Conference at OLL assists St. Anthony's Parish in Tigard with supplemental donated food along with providing for the food and volunteers to serve 80-90 meals at 6 seated dinners a year for the area underserved.

St. Anthony has been providing these types of dinners every Sunday evening in their Church Hall facility for many years. About 10 years ago, the OLL SVdP Conference officially became "Team 8" and we have served dinners with our team ever since.







In addition to the meal, our guests are treated to take items available to them, which include personal items like toothbrushes, toothpaste, socks, band aids, hair products, clothing and some selected food items. During the cold season, efforts are made to provide warm jackets, sleeping bags, and blankets.

No Employer Should be Forced to Participate in Abortion, says Bishop Rhoades

April 19, 2024

WASHINGTON - "No employer should be forced to participate in an employee's decision to end the life of their child," Bishop Kevin C. Rhoades of Fort Wayne-South Bend, chairman of the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops' (USCCB) Committee for Religious Liberty said today, in response to newly released regulations by the U.S. Equal Employment Opportunity Commission (EEOC). The regulations implement the Pregnant Workers Fairness Act, which itself provides helpful accommodations to pregnant women in the workplace. The EEOC, however, has defied Congress's intent and added a mandate for employers, including religious employers, to provide accommodations, such as leave time, for abortion.

Said Bishop Rhoades, "The bipartisan Pregnant Workers Fairness Act, as written, is a prolife law that protects the security and physical health of pregnant mothers and their preborn children. It is indefensible for the Equal Employment Opportunity Commission to twist the law in a way that violates the consciences of pro-life employers by making them facilitate abortions. No employer should be forced to participate in an employee's decision to end the life of their child."

The USCCB submitted formal comments to the EEOC in September 2023 (usccb.org/sites/default/files/about/general-counsel/rulemaking/upload/2023. USCCB_.CUA_.comments. PWFA_.regulations.pdf) when the federal agency proposed these regulations.
