You Will Be My Witnesses

You will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, throughout Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.

Acts 1:8

To give witness, to be a witness requires a bold spirit and a sense of responsibility and purpose. Whether in a court of law or in a spirited conversation with friends or strangers, when we are asked for what we know or have seen to be true, we need to speak from the heart with conviction. It takes courage to be a witness.

This weekend we celebrate the Ascension of the Lord into Heaven and hear St. Luke's account of how the first apostles witnessed Jesus' being taken up from their sight. I love the next line: "Men of Galilee, why are you standing there looking at the sky?" Basically, "The Men in White" call out the disciples for standing around when they just heard Jesus tell them to go to the "ends of the earth" to tell the Good News. Of course, we know the Holy Spirit did inspire them on Pentecost to go forth, and we are beneficiaries of their bold sacrifice through the ages to pass on the faith.

Tell the Stories of Grace and Blessing

One of the essential tasks of being a Christian disciple is to **tell the stories of grace and blessing** that we have received from Our Lord. The Good News we need to proclaim starts with recognizing our personal "good news" to share. Even in our darkest times—seasons of grief, physical difficulties, or life challenges, there are still glimpses of the light of Christ reaching us in small, yet significant ways.

What are the ways you have experienced God's love in the recent past? Perhaps you've received good news at work or school, or a favorable medical diagnosis. Maybe a friend or family member has done something special for you, or your child or parent who lives far away called to check in or send greetings for Mother's Day.

When we take time in prayer to give thanks for these simple blessings, we become more aware of God's abiding presence in our lives. Then, in our daily conversations and interactions, we can acknowledge and tell others of those graced moments.

Using Our Gifts for Others

The best way to share God's grace and blessings is to use our God-given talents for the good of others. In today's second reading we hear St. Paul encourage the Ephesians: "But grace was given to each of us according to the measure of Christ's gift." (Eph 4:11)

This is the work of the Church and each of our responsibilities as disciples. As we have been given, so we must give back. Jesus told the apostles that the "promise of the Father" would be to send the Holy

Spirit to them. Next Sunday, we will celebrate the great feast of Pentecost. Consider wearing something "red" to Mass as a reminder to yourself and others of that Great Commission.

What are the Gifts of the Holy Spirit you have been given and how can you use them in our parish and in the world? After all, they are not "gifts" if we don't find ways to give them away. How has God blessed you, and how are you being called in this moment to bless others with your time and talents?

Mother Knows Best

Finally, on this Mother's Day weekend, we honor and celebrate Our Blessed Mother, whom we call upon as Our Lady of the Lake. May she guide us personally and as a parish in doing God's will and sharing the Good News to the ends of the earth.

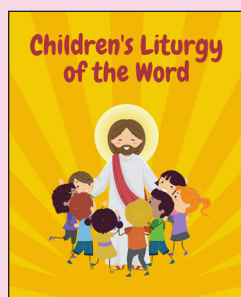

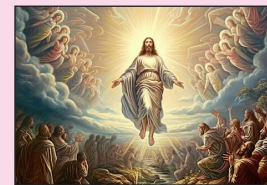

The Ascension of the Lord



Hello Children! I want you to understand three special

days in Jesus' life. The day Jesus died is called Good Friday, the day Jesus resurrected (rose from the dead) is called Easter Sunday and the day Jesus went up to heaven is called the ASCENSION of the Lord. Ascended means that Jesus arose or went up into heaven BODY AND SOUL by His power. By doing this, Jesus opened the gates of heaven for all of us. New Imagination on Migration

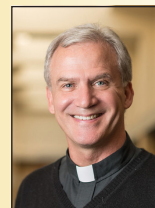


One of the world's top Catholic thinkers on migration will speak in Portland in June. Holy Cross Fr. Daniel Groody's latest book,

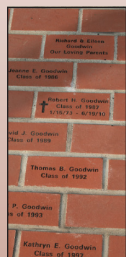
"A Theology of Migration: The Bodies of Refugees and the Body of Christ," includes a foreword from Pope Francis. In a talk organized by Catholic Charities of Oregon, Rev. Groody will speak at 7pm **Wednesday, June 12**, in Brian Doyle Auditorium at the University of Portland.

A professor and administrator at the University of Notre Dame, Fr. Groody has for decades traveled worldwide, met with migrants and deeply plumbed what migration means for life, society and faith. The priest not only examines the many instances of displacement and migration in Scripture—including the holy family—but reminds readers that Jesus made a migration from divinity to humanity. Also, Jesus came to reconcile humanity, Fr. Groody says, positing that the Christian life overall is a migration from brokenness to oneness.

Rev. Groody has served on the U.S. Catholic bishops' committee on migration. He advocates seeing the humanity of migrants. That differs from a rising narrative in the United States, which frames migrants in general as threats. "We don't just need more statistics about migration," says Father Groody. "We need a new imagination."
