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# Objectives

- The key objectives for parishioner feedback included an in-depth look at the following:
  - <u>Liturgy and Prayer (specifically the Mass)</u> Research questions focused on understanding how parishioners ranked church and Mass/Prayer attributes and to measure OLL performance on these same attributes. 10 characteristics were measured.
    - Follow-up questions explored ways for OLL to improve on all metrics.
    - The music programs and parishioner preferences for music styles were measured.
  - <u>Faith Formation (Adult & Youth programs)</u> Measure awareness and satisfaction with religious education programs and gain feedback on opportunities to improve.

# Methodology

- The survey was designed with input from Father John, Tom Tomaszek and the Liturgical staff.
- OLL did a substantial amount of promoting the survey beginning Easter weekend with an announcement in the Bulletin, announcements at Mass and by providing a way for non-registered parishioners to sign-up (opt-in) to take the survey. There was a random drawing for an incentive of five \$100 gift cards for those completing the survey.
- The survey was sent to 5,535 emails (dedupped) coming from the parish, school and the opt-in lists. The survey was deployed on May 11<sup>th</sup>, reminders were sent to unfinished respondents on May 16<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup>. There was a "bounce rate" of 10%. **806** individuals within the OLL community completed surveys for a 15% response rate.



# Highlights

- 69% of respondents are "Extremely satisfied" with the experience at the Mass they attend most often, 26% are "Somewhat satisfied" for a total of 95% satisfaction and leaving only 5% dissatisfied.
- **Regression analysis** determines which characteristics of the Mass are the key drivers to satisfaction, they are:
  - 1. Meaningful & inspiring homilies
  - 2. Music program that is engaging and uplifting
  - 3. A Mass experience that helps me feel closer to God
- 60% of respondents "regularly" attend one of the Saturday/Sunday masses.
  - Most are satisfied with the mass times; some would benefit from the return of Sunday 5 PM mass.
- Parishioners describe "beautiful music" when evaluating the individual mass ensembles/choirs. Nearly one-in-five individuals suggest the "mix of music styles" could be improved.



- **Relationship:** Most respondents to the survey are "registered parishioners at OLL" and many completing the survey are involved in other ways as volunteers, and on councils or committees.
- Tenure: More than half of respondents (57%) have been with the parish for 10+ years. "New this past year" is 8% and within "1-3 years" is 15%.



- Adults: 70% of those responding represented 2-person households.
- Gender: 67% of respondents were female, 31% male and 2% prefer not to say.
- <u>Children</u>: 70% of the parish responding does NOT have children in the household.
- Age of Adults: 19% of those responding are under age 45; 45% are Age 65+.
- Households with children (30% of total): 22% have children Less than 4 years old [these parents were later asked about the Nursery.]





## Who Responded


- Overall, the survey represents a group of parishioners who are very involved and engaged with church activities.
- One-in-four responding to the survey "strongly agree" they regularly serve in parish ministry or outreach and regularly attend other events or services at the church; 59% regularly participate in the sacraments, 64% contribute financially. These two characteristics increase to 84% agreement when including "somewhat agree."
- Most feel there is a good relationship between OLL Church and School; however, 46% "don't know."





#### Preferred communication method

- The preferred method of communicating with parishioners is via "parish emails" and the "weekly bulletin."
- The ranking does NOT change for younger v. older parishioners or for "regular" v. "not regular" Sunday Mass attendees.

# Summary – Who Responded

- The community that responded to this survey is <u>largely very engaged with OLL</u> with 84% saying they regularly receive sacraments at the Mass and contribute financially to support the parish.
- Similarly, 82% report they are registered parishioners.
- Only 2% of those responding indicate they are church or school staff, but a relatively large group, 25%, indicate they are music/liturgical ministers or involved in parish councils.
- Most have been with the parish for 10 or more years (57%.)
- Many (45%) are age 65+.
- 70% of those responding do not have children in the household.

#### CONVERSELY,

- 30% of those responding do have children.
- 39% are under age 54.
- 40% report they do not regularly attend services or events at OLL.

The next layer of understanding parishioner habits comes from evaluating reported Mass attendance.



#### Mass Attendance


- 60% of those responding to the survey regularly attend one of the four masses fulfilling a Sunday obligation. The remaining 40% is largely made up of those "occasionally attending" making up the largest group. About 12% are in the "seldom/never" group for all 4 masses.
- Online Streaming "Live" as well as at a later day/time is reaching nearly 40% of parishioners.
- The Thursday School Mass increases from 6% "regularly attend" overall to 14% when looking at the group most likely to be "seldom/never" for Sunday obligations.





#### **Overall Satisfaction**


- Most parishioners (69%) are extremely satisfied and 26% "somewhat satisfied" with the mass experience.
- Only 6% overall express some dissatisfaction.
- Mass times listed in the previous question have similar satisfaction scores overall with only 5% expressing dissatisfaction.





## Importance Attributes


- <u>"A Mass experience that helps me feel closer to God" is the MOST IMPORTANT attribute</u> followed by "Clergy and staff who are helpful and supportive," and "Meaningful and inspiring homilies."
- Even though the music program ranked lower in importance its "importance" rating was 77%.





## Is OLL Fulfilling....

- All characteristics have at least 90% of respondents indicating the OLL experience is fulfilling. Ranked below are the 10 attributes ranked from highest to lowest.
- Rating highest for OLL is "Participating in the sacraments."






Q - Thinking about these same attributes, how fulfilling is your experience with each of the following at Our Lady of the Lake?


Step 1: Combining extremely important + very important.





# In-depth Gap Analysis


Step 2: Combine "extremely fulfilling" and "very fulfilling evaluations" of OLL





## In-depth Gap Analysis [Gap is calculated in Red]

- Step 3: Side-by-side Calculate difference, compare for strengths/weaknesses.
- While all attributes are in a negative position, that's not uncommon, expectations are high from those who really care.
- <u>OLL largest negative gap is for the two statements of "community & belonging" and "hospitality & welcome."</u> Other attributes requiring some attention include the music program, the homilies and the Mass experience that helps one to feel closer to God."






## Regression Analysis

Regression analysis is a reliable method of identifying which variables have impact on another variable. The process of
performing a regression identifies which factors matter the most. In this scenario which of the 10 characteristics are the most
significant "drivers" of SATISFACTION?



Regression tells us that "meaningful and inspiring homilies accounts for 27% relative importance when evaluating ones'
satisfaction with the overall mass experience. "Music program" accounts for 26% and "a mass experience that helps me feel
closer to God is highly correlated but not statistically significant. These three variables account for 67% of the relative
importance










#### Music Evaluations: 9:00 am Music Ensemble



# Children's/Teen Choir

- 47% of all respondents felt a children's choir would be important.
- 57% express it would be important to have teen musicians & singers.
- These percentages do not change significantly for households with children, a slight increase of 1-2% points.







• Re-opening the Nursery has positive response with 69% of those with age-appropriate children expressing likelihood to use?









- Church doctrines have made 19% of parishioners question their commitments to the faith.



# Most outstanding attributes

- 95% of Parishioners are satisfied with Our Lady of the Lake Mass experience.
- When asked to evaluate attributes of OLL, parishioners gave giving the highest ratings to Participating in the sacraments:
  - I. Participating in the sacraments
  - II. Clergy and staff who are helpful and supportive
  - III. A Mass experience that helps me feel closer to God
  - IV. Meaningful and inspiring homilies
- OLL performs highest (using Gap analysis) on the following 4 attributes:
  - I. Participating in the Sacraments
  - II. Visiting and taking communion to the homebound (ranked lowest in Importance)
  - III. Providing help and support to those in need
  - IV. Clergy and staff are helpful and supportive
- The key drivers of satisfaction include:
  - I. Meaningful and inspiring homilies,
  - II. A music program that is engaging and uplifting,
  - III. A Mass experience that helps me feel closer to God.

Attributes are color-coded for easy reference to Gap Analysis and Key Drivers. For Example, "Participating in the sacraments is #1 in fulfillment ratings and also OLL performs best on this attribute in the Gap Analysis (both highlighted in blue.)



## Areas for Attention

- Among the attributes scoring lowest on the fulfillment scale are:
  - I. A music program that is engaging and uplifting
  - II. Providing faith formation and religious education programs
    - Awareness of everything OLL provides for children, families and adults could be improved upon.
  - III. Sense of community & belonging
  - IV. Spirit of hospitality and welcome
- The attributes with the <u>largest gap</u> from importance include:
  - I. Sense of community and belonging
  - II. Spirit of hospitality and welcome
  - III. A music program that is engaging and uplifting
  - IV. Meaningful and inspiring homilies
