It is an exciting time at Our Lady of the Lake Parish. We are growing. Over 100 children each week participate in the Children's Liturgy of the Word during Sunday morning Masses. Our outreach to those in need and activities for spiritual growth are in full swing. On Sunday, October 13, 2024, we launched our *Building Our Future – A Sacred Presence* campaign to complete the plans we started in 2015.
