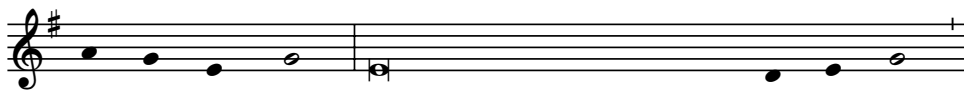





THE ANGELUS

The Angelus, which recalls the moment of the Annunciation of the angel Gabriel to Mary, is traditionally prayed at 6am, 12pm, and 6pm. The congregation responses appear in bold.

is the fruit of thy womb, Jesus.

And dwelt among us.

Hail Mary...

Pray for us, O Holy Mother of God,
